The Village Design Statement has also highlighted the need to protect and enhance Grayshott's design heritage.

The aims of Grayshott Society are to:

- Lobby for improved design in new development.
- Work with existing property owners to improve the appearance of important buildings.
- Liaise and work with other village groups.
- Help with the extension of the conservation area.
- Research the sources of grants for village projects.
- Help the Parish Council deliver the vision described in the Village Design Statement.
- Support future projects depending on village interest. For example; the purchasing of the Village Square and the design/revamping of it, or the start up of any proposed cultural projects.



To sum up, the main aims of a Grayshott Society are:

- To seek the protection and improvement of the amenities and appearance of the village.
- To promote interest in local history and local life.
- To enrich the enjoyment of Grayshott Village and its countryside.
- To advise on and disseminate knowledge of the geography, natural history, buildings and architecture of the village.

A small group of people have looked into the role of a Grayshott Society and put their case forward. This has resulted in getting the support of the parish Council, Grayshott District Councillor and leader of E.H.D.C Ferris Cowper.
