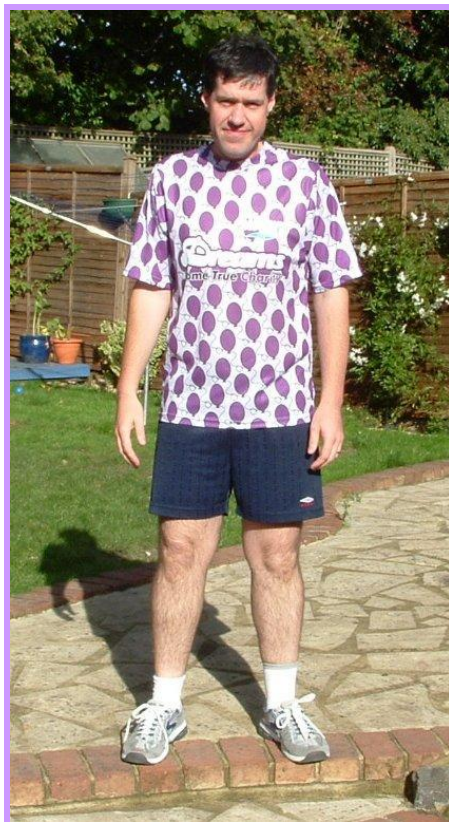




“Making the most treasured dreams of serious and terminally ill children come true”
